

Proposed by: Lee McGuire

I wish to propose an updated General Rule Book for the 2017 AGM.

No changes to the constitution are proposed here.

The reason behind this is that our current rule book

1. has conflicting rules
2. Means we must stick to one format of racing. i.e. 3 qual, 2 finals. We cannot change and do something interesting unless something is proposed at the AGM.
The proposal removes a number of items in the "race format section" of the current rule book, and gives a list of items the committee must publish in advance of a championship. So this will not allow for the changing of rules during a championship.
3. Goes over the top on some rules, e.g. batteries. At club level we should not restrict drivers to whats on the EFRA list.

This rule book simplifies a lot of rules, removes over the top rules, and allows us to change race formats for championships.

There are no changes to weights and measures.

The majority of the book has not been changed, just simplified.

I would suggest you read it before the AGM.

There is also no reason if this rule book is accepted by the membership, that other proposals cannot be added to it.
