

DMCC Rule Change Proposal 5

Rule number to be changed: 3.2 Four Wheel Drive

Current rule:

3.2 Four Wheel Drive

Four Wheel Drive will have two sub categories:

Four Wheel Drive Open: where there are no restrictions to motor winds. Four Wheel Drive Clubman: where there will be restrictions.

Any car competing in the 4WD Class must have effective drive to the front and rear wheels (excluding race breakages). Any car which is designated as 4WD must be able to complete a lap of the track, with either the front or rear drive-shafts removed and all settings of the remaining drive-train as it will be raced, in a reasonable time frame.

Proposed change/addition: (addition to end of rule)

Temporary rule until numbers in 4WD increase. Until there we are seeing 5 Clubman level drivers and 5 Open level drivers, all racers in 4WD will race together. They will be graded as per rule 3.5 as F1, F2 and F3. There will be no separate "clubman 4WD championship".

Option: 4WD F3 drivers will have the same motor and timing restrictions as Clubman.

Reason for change:

On average, 4WD open has 2 drivers and 4WD clubman has less than 2!

In Clubman only 1 driver even did the number of counting rounds for the last 2 championships.

Putting all drivers together might make the class look more interesting, and push the faster drivers in clubman to improve.
